Top 10 Winter Tips



With temperatures dropping across the country, it is a good idea to carry out a few quick checks around your home and garden to prepare for the colder months.

Here are our top ten easy, cost-effective steps you can take to help prevent damage to your property this winter.

- 1. Protect your pipework-Lag (insulate) any exposed pipe to prevent them from freezing as the temperatures drop.
- 2. Insulate your loft- An average house can lose approximately 25% of its heat through a loft space. By insulating this space you will retain this heat and lower those heating bills (remember not to obstruct ventilation).
- 3. Prevent Draughts- Block up unnecessary draught from letter boxes, windows and doors.
- 4. Get you boiler serviced- a serviced boiler will be more efficient and less likely to break down when you need it the most.
- 5. Stock up on salt- for use on driveways and paths allowing safe access.
- 6. Drain down water system on empty properties or turn the thermostat to the 'frost' setting.
- 7. Fix any small cracks in masonry- this will prevent water from penetrating, freezing and expanding causing further damage.
- 8. Clear the gutters. Leaves etc. will block the gutters causing them to overflow.
- 9. Isolate any outside water supplies to prevent freezing.
- 10. Stop cock- make sure you know the location of your stop cock so you can isolate it in the event of an emergency.
